


#### **Doll exhibition**


#### **Puppet show**

Children recited shlokas, sang songs and spoke about Ganesha festival. Ganesha idols made by children using clay was displayed class wise to exhibit their talents.

























#### Sri Krishna Janmashtami celebration

- Children in mahabali and kerala traditional costumes were depicting the folklore of onam.


















# **Independence Day Celebration**
